PLEASE READ THIS ENTIRE SHEET AND KEEP FOR YOUR RECORDS

- 1. If you are receiving two degrees, please complete two separate applications.
- 2. If you are currently enrolled, you should apply on SalukiNet. If not, **undergraduate students** should complete the graduation application form at http://registrar.siu.edu/pdf/GraduationApplication.pdf. Please mail, email or fax your application to the address in the upper right hand corner of this sheet.
- 3. Graduation aplication deadlineare available at http://commencement.siu.edu/faqs/index/html
- There is <u>no</u> August commencement, but your degreecan be completed during the Summer term.
- 5. A confirmation notification and other correspondence regarding graduation will be sentto your SIU email account. To set up your SIU email, please go to https://netid.siu.edu, if you have notalready set up your account.
- 6. A non-refundable graduation application fee will appear on a future Bursar statement unless you indicate that you have one of the financial aid awards listed on the application.
- 7. Thegraduation application fee does not cover the cost of cap and gown rental or invitations. Degree candidates planning to attend commencement should contact the University Bockstore in the Student Center (618-536-3321) about ordering their cap,gown, and invitations. - 8. If all graduation requirements are **not** complete and on file with SIU within 5 weeks from the last day of the term, it will be your responsibility to submit a new graduation application by the deadline for the term in which you then plan to graduate. The new application will result in the assessment of a new graduation application fee.
- 9. All financial obligations with the university must be cleared with the Bursar's Office before the release of your diploma and official transgipt. Diplomas are mailed 4 to 10 weeksafter the end of the term. The diploma will be mailed to the address on your graduation application.
